Grant that their hearts may be exalted and that they may be enabled worthily to glorify thy holy name. We ask it for the sake of thy Son, our Saviour, Jesus Christ. Amee.

Grant, we beseech thee, blessed Lord, that all who shall ascend these steps and enter this portal of thy holy temple and shall draw near to thee in this place to give thee thanks for the henefits which they have received at thy hands, to set forth thy most worthy praise, to confess their sins unto thee, and to ask such things as a requisite and necessary, as well for the holy as for the soul, may do it with such scridings of faith, and with such scriousness, affection, and devotion of mind, that thou mayest accept their bounden duty and service, and vonebaste to give whatever in thy islinite wisdom thou shalt see to be most expedient for them. All which we beg for the sake of Jesus Christ, our most blessed Lord and Suviour. Amen.

Then shall the Bishop dedicate the North Porch in the following words:

In the faith of Jesus Christ, I, James Edward Freeman, Bishop of Washington, do dedicate this North Porch of the Cathedral of Saint Peter and Saint Paul to the glory of God and in grateful recognition of faithful women whose Christian seal and service have enriched both Church and Nation and whose generous gifts erected this Women's Porch. In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.

The Congregation will join the Choir in singing:
