Grant, we beseech thee, bleseed Lard, that all who shall ascend these steps and enter this portal of thy holy temple and shall draw near to thee in this plave to give thee thanks for the henefite which they have received at thy hands, to eet forth thy moot worthy praise, to confess their sins unto thee, and to ask such things as are requisite and socessary, as well for the holly as for the soul, may do it with such stcadinese of faith, asd with such seriousnesk affection, and devation of mind, that thou mayest accept their bounden duty and service, und vouchafe to give whatever in thy infinite wisdom thou shalt see to be most expedient for them. All which we beg for the sake of Jesue Christ, wur most blessed Lord and Saviour. Amen.
